School Physicals

A reminder to all kindergarten and 7th grade students, any new student coming from out of state, and ALL student athletes: You must have a physical before enrolling in school or participating in fall sports practices. Forms are available in the office.

PowerSchool Parent Single Sign On

When logging into PowerSchool you will find a new feature....Parent Single Sign-On!

A parent/guardian account allows you to view the information for one or more students with a single login. You can also manage your personal account preferences.

Parents/Guardians will now need to create their own user name and password and set up each of their students accounts by using each of the **PARENT'S** Access ID (Old Web ID) and Access Password (old Web Password) per student.

*When entering your student's information you will need to enter the Parent ID and Password **NOT** the Student ID and Password

*A parent with only one student would still need to create their own account, but they would only enter one student's information instead of multiple students.

To create a parent/guardian account, log into PowerSchool, click on Create a New Account and enter the following information:

- **Name** - Your first and last name
- **Email** - Student notifications and correspondence related to your parent/guardian account will be sent to this email
- **Desired User Name** - Your user name is your unique PowerSchool identity
- **Password** - Your password must be at least 6 characters long
- **Student Access Information** - Information for a minimum of one student, including the student name, **PARENT** Access ID (Old Web ID), **PARENT** Access Password (Old Web Password), and your relationship to the student

Common data entry errors include not completing all fields, entering an email address or user name that is already associated to another account, or entering incorrect access IDs or passwords. When this occurs, parents/guardians will need to re-enter any information that was not entered correctly, and also re-enter any passwords for security reasons.



Important Information for 7-12 Students

1. **School Begins:** The first day of school for students will be Monday, August 17th. School will dismiss at 11:40 a.m. on Monday the 17th and Tuesday the 18th.
2. **School Hours.** Classes begin promptly at 8:20 a.m. and end at 3:45 p.m.
3. **Dress Code.** As you begin your back to school shopping, please remember the school dress code. **Appearance is the responsibility of the student and his/her parent.** Students are expected to be appropriately dressed and acceptably groomed for school and school activities. Clothing shall not disrupt classroom decorum, and shall comply with reasonable standards of cleanliness and decency. **Footwear is required.**

Dress Code cont.

The following types of clothing WILL NOT be permitted:

- *Short shorts/skirts (must be no shorter than mid thigh)
- *Halters and exposed midriff blouses or shirts
- *Mesh shirts, athletic tank tops, and spaghetti straps must be worn with a solid shirt underneath with sleeves that extend past shoulders
- *Head gear of any kind
- *Clothing bearing patches or insignias of alcoholic beverages, drugs, tobacco, profanity or suggestive inscriptions
- *Ripped or torn clothing, cut-off jeans or cut-off sweats
- *Any style of dress or personal expression that brings and draws unnecessary attention to you or causes disruption within the school or classroom
- *Ornaments in body piercing may only be worn in the ear
