The first donations accepted and allocated for student benefit took the form of a single scholarship for a graduating senior in 1993.

With donor support, the Foundation now awards multiple scholarships annually.

Twelve students from the 2010 graduating class received scholarship awards, which ranged from \$500 to \$1000 each.

Max VonSeggern received the **Baum Family Scholarship**, awarded to a student whose scholarly fields of interests are among business, education, medicine or technology.

Noah Blomendahl and Jodi Popken were awarded **Mindy Schrieber Memorial Scholarships**.

The **Edna Pfeiffer Music Scholarship** was awarded to Jordan Peters.

Utilizing the collective giving capacity of undirected donations, five students were awarded **Logan View Education Foundation** college scholarships for pursuit of any field of interest. Recipients are Kendra Bloch, Emily Dahl, Tyler Popken, Carol Ready and Kaitlin Scholl.
