

SUMMARY OF THE SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION RULES AND REGULATIONS 2010-2011

Student Age Group	Required Vaccines
2-5 year olds enrolled in a school based program not licensed as a child care provider.	<p>4 doses of DTap, DTP, or DT vaccine</p> <p>3 doses of Polio vaccine</p> <p>3 doses of Hib vaccine or 1 dose of Hib given at or after 15 months of age</p> <p>3 doses of pediatric Hepatitis B vaccine</p> <p>1 dose of MMR or MMRV given on or after 12 months of age.</p> <p>1 dose of varicella (chickenpox) or MMRV given on or after 12 months of age. Written documentation (including year) or varicella disease from parent, guardian, or health care provider will be accepted.</p>
Students entering school for the first time (K or 1 st grade)	<p>3 doses of DTaP, DTP, DT or Td vaccine, one given on or after the 4th birthday</p> <p>3 doses of Polio vaccine</p> <p>3 doses of pediatric Hepatitis B vaccine or 2 doses of adolescent vaccine if student is 11-15 years of age.</p>
Students entering 7 th grade	<p>2 doses of MMR or MMRV vaccine, given on or after 12 months of age and separated by at least one month</p> <p>1 dose of varicella (chickenpox) or MMRV if given on or after 12 months of age and prior to 13 years of age. If given at or over 13 years of age, 2 doses of varicella (no MMRV), separated by at least one month. Written documentation (including year) of varicella disease from parent, guardian or health care provider will be accepted. (For the 2010-2011 school year, this includes students in grades kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, plus all out of state transfer students).</p>
Transfer students from outside the State of Nebraska, regardless of grade (includes any foreign students)	<p>2 doses of MMR or MMRV vaccine, given on or after 12 months of age and separated by at least one month</p> <p>1 dose of varicella (chickenpox) or MMRV if given on or after 12 months of age and prior to 13 years of age. If given at or over 13 years of age, 2 doses of varicella (no MMRV), separated by at least one month. Written documentation (including year) of varicella disease from parent, guardian or health care provider will be accepted. (For the 2010-2011 school year, this includes students in grades kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, plus all out of state transfer students).</p>
All students not listed above (grades 1 through 6 and 8 through 12)	<p>3 doses of DTaP, DTP, DT, or Td vaccine, one given on or after the 4th birthday</p> <p>3 doses of polio vaccine</p> <p>3 doses of pediatric Hepatitis B vaccine or 2 doses of adolescent vaccine if student is 11-15 years of age.</p> <p>2 doses of MMR or MMRV vaccine, given on or after 12 months of age and separated by at least one month</p> <p>For the 2010-2011 school year Varicella is required for kindergartners, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th, graders, plus all out of state transfers.</p>
